As you are aware, the Central Government enacted the Bonded Labour System Dear Mr. Keemas, (Abolition) Act, 1976 whereby all persons in any form of debt bondage or forced labour had been freed from rendering such services. The Central Government had also launched a Centrally Sponsored Scheme for rehabilitation of bonded labourers. The scheme has since been modified to include the component of survey, awareness generation and evaluation study apart from enhancing the rehabilitation assistance for rehabilitation of bonded labour to Rs.20,000 per bonded labour, to be equally shared by the Central and

As a consequence of the steps taken by the Government, the incidence of bonded State Government. labour has been coming down over the years. However, some cases are still being reported from different parts of the country. The subject matter of bonded labour is a very sensitive one and each case tends to get highlighted at various fora. It is, therefore, necessary to keep a track of events in this context.
